NOTICE is hereby given that the staff of the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) will conduct a customer meeting to discuss Florida Community Water Systems, Inc. (FCWS or "Utility") application for a revenue-neutral rate restructuring limited proceeding for the fourteen water and wastewater systems the Utility owns in Brevard, Lake, and Sumter counties. The meeting will be held virtually on the following date and time:

#### Tuesday, June 20, 2023, at 10 a.m.

### PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this meeting is to give customers and other interested persons an opportunity to offer comments to Commission staff regarding the quality of service the Utility provides and on the preliminary rates included in this notice. Customers and other interested persons may be asked follow-up questions. These comments will be taken into consideration by the Commission in its decision regarding the proposed rate increase.

This customer meeting will be conducted virtually. The Commission shall act as the host of the customer meeting and will use a combination of technologies to ensure full participation. The Commission will employ GoToMeeting as an audio and video platform for the meeting, and also will provide for simultaneous, audio-only participation by telephone. You will need to provide your name, address, and the name of the Utility (FCWS). Please note: the order in which customers speak at the customer meeting is based upon the order in which they sign up. of the Commissioners may attend and participate in this meeting. The meeting will begin as scheduled and will continue until all the customers have been heard.

#### INITIAL NOTICE - BACKGROUND

FCWS is a water and wastewater utility whose corporate offices are located at 4939 Cross Bayou Blvd, New Port Richey, Florida. The Utility's water and wastewater facilities are located in Brevard, Lake, and Sumter Counties, Florida.

On November 14, 2022, FCWS filed an application for a revenue-neutral rate restructuring limited proceeding for the fourteen water and wastewater systems the Utility owns in Brevard, Lake, and Sumter Counties. The Application was assigned Docket No. 20220201-WS.

In the Utility's November 14, 2022, petition for limited proceeding, FCWS seeks uniform rates for these systems. FCWS states that the various rates charged by each system are widely disparate. Based on the Utility's proposed uniform rates, if granted, it would result in a reduction in typical residential bills, except for Lakeside wastewater customers and all Harbor customers, and would provide significant relief to the customers in the financially distressed systems.

Commission staff will prepare a recommendation which is tentatively scheduled to be submitted to the Commission on July 20, 2023. The Commission will then vote on staff's recommendation at its August 1, 2023 Commission Conference. As noted above, customers may address the Commission directly at this Conference. Look for the "Watch Live Broadcast" icon on the left side of the webpage.

The Commission will thereafter issue a proposed agency action (PAA) order containing rates which may be different from those contained in staff's final recommendation. Substantially affected persons have 21 days from the date that the PAA order is issued to protest the Commission's PAA order. Customers are able to obtain a copy of staff's recommendation and all documents filed in this docket under the Clerk's Office tab at the Commission's website (http://www.floridapsc.com/).
