I graduated from the University of South Florida in 1990 with

I have more than 25 years of experience working in the gas and electric utility industry. My career began at Tampa Electric Company as a legal assistant in 1996, and since then, I have held numerous positions in different departments, including Customer Service and Fuels Management. In June 2018, I was appointed as Manager of Regulatory Affairs for Peoples, and in July 2023, I was promoted to Director.

Q. What are the purposes of your prepared direct testimony in this proceeding?

A. The purposes of my testimony are to present and support tariff modifications as part of the company's request for an increase in base rates in this proceeding. Specifically, I will describe proposed modifications to the: (1) miscellaneous service charges; (2) rate schedules; and (3) non-rate related language within the company's tariff.
