Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) requests confidential classification of certain information contained in TECO's Second Annual Microgrid Pilot Annual Report. TECO requests confidentiality of the information under Sections 366.093(3)(d), F.S., which states: "Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S., which states: "Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

The information for which TECO requests confidentiality can be described as the costs incurred by BlockEnergy to operate and maintain the DC microgrid.

Staff has reviewed TECO's confidentiality requests described above and determined that disclosure of the confidential information identified could impair TECO's efforts to contract goods and services and competitive interests. Therefore, staff recommends that this information meets the criteria for confidential classification pursuant to their respective subparts of Section 366.093(3), F.S.
