Good morning Mr. Rendell,

Thank you for providing a response to Staff's Second Data Request concerning Owner's Salaries. In the Utility's response, staff was directed to review Document No. 05916-2023, which was the Utility's response to staff's audit report. In reviewing the document, the Utility provided previously-approved Owner's Salaries amounts, the most recent being from Order No. PSC-2022-0335-PAA-WS, issued September 28, 2022, in Docket No. 20220066-WS, a File and Suspend rate case for Sunny Hills Utility Company. In that docket, staff did not adjust the Utility's recorded Owner's Salary expense of \$9,900.

When Order No. PSC-2022-0335-PAA-WS was issued, Sunny Hills Utility Company had 577 customers. With the Owner's Salary of \$9,900 being approved, that calculates to \$17.15 per customer. In the instant docket, Docket No. 20230081-WS, a File and Suspend rate case for Royal Waterworks, the Utility recorded a combined Owner's Salary of \$58,000 (\$30,000 for water and \$28,000 for wastewater). According to its 2022 Annual Report, Royal Waterworks has 1,043 customers.

Staff used the previously-approved rate of \$17.15 per customer for Royal Waterworks, and calculated an Owner's Salary expense of \$17,887. Increasing that amount to reflect the 7.07 percent 2023 Price Index approved in Order No. PSC-2022-0438-PAA-WS, staff calculates a total Owner's Salary expense of \$19,247.

Please explain in detail how a salary of \$58,000 was calculated for Royal Waterworks.
