On December 21, 2023, pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida (DEF or Company) requested a second extension of confidential classification for certain information contained in the transcript for the deposition of Terry Hobbs that was taken on June 25, 2020, along with late-filed Exhibit 3 to said deposition. The material that is the subject of this confidentiality request appears in Document No. 03943-2020 and is cross-referenced to Document Nos. 03523-2020 and 03606-2020.

On July 21, 2020, DEF filed the original Request for Confidential Classification related to this document. DEF's Request was granted by Order No. PSC-2020-0361-CFO-EI on October 12, 2020. Subsequently, on March 29, 2022, DEF filed its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification for this document. That request was granted by Order No. PSC-2022-0236-CFO-EI on June 27, 2022.

The Company is claiming confidentiality for certain information contained within the transcript of Terry Hobbs deposition, along with late-filed Exhibit 3, under Section 366.093(3), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsections (d) "[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and (e) "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information." The information provided in the aforementioned deposition and exhibit for which confidential treatment is being sought can be described as information revealing "activity over the years" relating to DEF's Nuclear Decommissioning Trust.

Staff has reviewed the information contained in the transcript and documents produced by DEF, as well as the Company's confidentiality request. In staff's opinion, the information that is the subject of the confidentiality request does meet the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the current request for extension of confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 03943-2020 be approved.
