EFFLUENT REUSE - The use of wastewater after the treatment process, generally for reuse as irrigation water or for in plant use. (Section 367.021 (6), Florida Statutes)

EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL CONNECTION (ERC) - (WATER)- (Rule 25-30.515 (8), Florida Administrative Code)

- (a) 350 gallons per day
- (b) The number of gallons a utility demonstrates in the average daily flow for a single family unit; or
- (c) The number of gallons which has been approved by the DEP for a single family residential unit.

EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL CONNECTION (ERC) - (WASTEWATER) - Industry standard of 80% of Water ERC or 280 gallons per day for residential use.

GUARANTEED REVENUE CHARGE - A charge designed to cover the utility's costs including, but not limited to, the cost of operation, maintenance, depreciation and any taxes, and to provide a reasonable return to the utility for facilities, a portion of which may not be used and useful to the utility or its existing customers.
