SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

2.19 Use of Service

Effective February 1, 2009, the Company will no longer offer presubscribed long distance service to new residential and small business customers in areas in which local exchange service is provided by any subsidiary or affiliate of Verizon not subject to this tariff. Residential and small business customers currently subscribed to Company long distance service will no longer be able to move, add to, or change the service to which they are subscribed, except that customers may switch to a different Company service for which they are eligible if they wish, and customers of local/long distance integrated service may cancel local features on their service if they wish. All residential and small business end users will continue to be able to access the Company network and will be subject to this tariff on a non-presubscribed basis, e.g. collect calling, "dial around" services, or where their local exchange carrier installs the Company as the long distance PIC without the customer directly signing up with the Company for any calling plan.
