Executive Summary

Introduction

This tariff filing removes Three-Digit (N11) Dialing Service from the list of calls that can not be placed from lines equipped with certain Customized Code Restriction options.

The N11 codes will no longer be restricted because they are no longer used for commercial purposes and they no longer generate usage charges for the caller. The Customized Code Restriction options that previously blocked these codes were Options 1, 6 and 7.
