T Order Closer Waiver

Overview

The T Order Closer Waiver promotion is scheduled to begin on October 1, 2007 and end on September 30, 2008. Existing customers who place an order to move their service to a new location through a Consumer Inbound sales channel may be eligible for a waiver of the line connection charge.

Promotion Specifics

Customers who place an order to move their service (T order) to a new location through the Consumer Inbound sales channel may be eligible for a waiver of the line connection charge if they meet the eligibility requirements. Sales Associate will manually waive the charges on the T order.

Promotion Restrictions/Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Available to existing customers who place an order to move their service to a new location through a Consumer Inbound sales channel may be eligible for a waiver of the line connection charge.
- 2. T orders to move service must be issued between October 1, 2007 and September 30, 2008 to qualify for the promotional offer.
