This filing increases charges for the following:

Business and Residence – The charge for checks or drafts presented for payment for service which is not accepted by the institution on which it was written; the charge for Directory Assistance Service; the local and intraLATA toll service charge for all Operator Assisted Station-to-Station calls other than calls when the customer dials and uses a credit card; and the local and intraLATA toll service charge for all Person-to-Person calls.

Residence only – The usage-sensitive charge for Custom Calling Feature Three-Way Calling; the usage-sensitive charges for ExpressTouch Features Return Call and Repeat Dial.

Business only – The minimum for the Late Payment Charge.
