A RESOLUTION REQUESTING FLORIDA WATER SERVICES TO DECREASE RATES FOR POTABLE WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH RESOLUTION NO. 961131A0, WHICH DECREASED RATES FOR CHARLOTTE COUNTY UTILITIES.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on September 23, 1997, whereby all the owners, tenants and occupants of property served or to be served by the Charlotte County Water and Sewer District No. 1 (hereinafter, "District") and all others interested, had an opportunity to confer concerning the preliminary Schedule fixing water, sewer and gas utility rates, fees and charges, notice of which public hearing was properly and timely published in a newspaper published in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, on the advice and recommendation of its technical advisors, and after hearing comments from the public, has established a new Schedule fixing water, sewer, and gas utility rates, fees and charges for customers within the District, as reflected by Resolution No. 961131A0; and

WHEREAS, the County has entered into agreements with Florida Water Services through which Florida Water Services purchases potable bulk water and bulk wastewater services from the County at bulk rates and provides those services to its customers in Charlotte County; and

WHEREAS, Florida Water Services has previously passed rate increases through to its Charlotte County customers that are served via bulk purchase from Charlotte County Utilities;
