Dear Chairman Johnson:

In Docket No. 960789-EI, Gulf petitioned the Commission and received approval (Order No. PSC-96-1219-FOF-EI) of a Limited Availability Experimental Rate Commercial/Industrial Service Rider (CISR) tariff. This rider allows Gulf the flexibility to negotiate and execute Contract Service Arrangements (CSA, contract or agreement) with eligible customers with at risk load in excess of 500 KW. This letter is not intended to be the formal notification required by the order which will be filed with the June Surveillance Report. However, I wanted to give you notification prior to that time.

This CSA, which is Gulf's first, was executed under the terms and conditions of the CISR tariff and Pilot Study Implementation Plan. We are pleased to reach this agreement and retain this customer's load. This contract preserves a contribution toward the Company's fixed costs that would otherwise be lost, to the ultimate benefit of Gulf's customers. In addition, this CSA retains the positive economic impact which this customer has on northwest Florida and the State. This agreement helps to sustain approximately 300 jobs, \$99 million dollars of economic impact and tax receipts of \$4 million dollars for our area.

The request for confidential classification of the data, referenced in Document No. 08659-98, has been made pursuant to the Pilot Study Implementation Plan (Plan) approved in Order No. PSC-96-1219-FOF-EI. While the approval of the Plan does not confer automatic confidentiality, its provisions contemplate that the data would be filed separately so that it could be subject to the procedures for handling confidential and proprietary information.

The Staff agrees with GULF's assertions that the release of the information contained in Supplemental 2 could cause harm to both GULF and entity that has entered into the Contract Service Agreement (CSA) contract. At the present time, it appears that Gulf Power Company (GULF) has two customers with which it has negotiated a CSA contract under the Commercial/Industrial Service Rider (CISR) tariff. A sophisticated member of the public could use the information to estimate the amount of the discount provided to the entity and use it to its own advantage, especially in any CISR negotiations with GULF. The future need for confidentiality will diminish if at least three entities enter into CSA contracts.

Staff recommends that the information referenced in Document No. 08659-98 be granted confidential classification pursuant to §366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

The request for confidential classification of the data, referenced in Document No. 02013-00, has been made pursuant to the Pilot Study Implementation Plan (Plan) approved in Order No. PSC-96-1219-FOF-EI. While the approval of the Plan does not confer automatic confidentiality, its provisions contemplate that the data would be filed separately so that it could be subject to the procedures for handling confidential and proprietary information.

The Staff agrees with GULF's assertions that the release of the information contained in Supplemental 2 could cause harm to both GULF and entity that has entered into the Contract Service Agreement (CSA) contract. At the present time, it appears that Gulf Power Company (GULF) has two customers with which it has negotiated a CSA contract under the Commercial/Industrial Service Rider (CISR) tariff. A sophisticated member of the public could use the information to estimate the amount of the discount provided to the entity and use it to its own advantage, especially in any CISR negotiations with GULF. The future need for confidentiality will diminish if at least three entities enter into CSA contracts.

Staff recommends that the information referenced in Document No. 02013-00 be granted confidential classification pursuant to §366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

The request for confidential classification of the data (Document No. 00706-01) has been made pursuant to the Pilot Study Implementation Plan (Plan) approved in Order No. PSC-96-1219-FOF-EI. While the approval of the Plan does not confer automatic confidentiality, its provisions contemplate that the data would be filed separately so that it could be subject to the procedures for handling confidential and proprietary information.

The Staff agrees with GULF's assertions that the release of the information contained in Supplemental 2 could cause harm to both GULF and any entity that has entered into the Contract Service Agreement (CSA) contract. At the present time, it appears that GULF has two customers with which it has negotiated a CSA contract under the Commercial/Industrial Service Rider (CISR) tariff. A sophisticated member of the public could use the information to estimate the amount of the discount provided to the entity and use it to its own advantage, especially in any CISR negotiations with GULF. The future need for confidentiality will diminish if at least three entities enter into CSA contracts.

Staff recommends that the information in Document No. 00706-01 be granted confidential classification pursuant to §366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

On March 5, 2001, the Orlando Utilities Commission (OUC), filed its Second Request for Confidential Classification for information contained in Document No. 02881-01. This document is the petitioner's Confidential Exhibit C, Exhibits PAA-3 and PAA-4 attached to the prefiled direct testimony of witness Paul Arsuaga. This document contains the evaluations of the proposals OUC received in response to its Requests for Power Supply Proposals (RFP) of generating alternatives.

OUC asserts that Document No. 02881-01 contains proprietary, confidential business information, as defined in Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. Bidders responding to OUC's Power Supply RFP consider their pricing proposals to be confidential and competitively sensitive. OUC assured these bidders that their responses would be treated as confidential. OUC asserts that disclosure of this information will impair its ability to engage in meaningful solicitations in the future.

Staff concurs with OUC's request to grant confidential status to Document No. 02881-01. However, in accord with Section 366.093(4), Florida Statutes, staff recommends that Document No. 02881-01 remain confidential for a period of eighteen months from the date of the request. Prior to the end of the eighteen month time period, it is anticipated that either OUC can renew its request for confidential status or the affected document can be returned to OUC.
