Docket No. 20190118-WU – Application for increase in water rates in Gulf County by Lighthouse Utilities Company, Inc.

Lighthouse Utilities Company (Lighthouse or Utility) filed an application for a limited proceeding rate increase on September 26, 2018. On May 17, 2019, by letter, Lighthouse conveyed its desire to withdraw its September 26, 2018 application and file an application for general rate relief. Lighthouse's request for general rate relief will be taken up in Docket No. 20190118-WU. In the same letter, Lighthouse requested that the filing fee paid in Docket No. 20180179-WU be credited toward the Utility's subsequent application for general rate relief in Docket No. 20190118-WU. Pursuant to Section 2.07(C)(2)(d)(4), of the Administrative Procedures Manual, staff may administratively close dockets initiated by the filing of an application in which the applicant seeks to withdraw its initial pleading and staff has determined that there are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission regarding the filing and no request for refund of filing fee has been made. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel and Division of Accounting & Finance request that Docket No. 20180179-WU be closed and that the filing fee previously paid in Docket No. 20180179-WU be credited toward the Utility's filing fee in Docket No. 20190118-WU.
