Pursuant to Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida, LLC ("DEF") requests confidential classification of certain information provided in response to PCS Phosphate's [White Springs'] 2nd request for PODs (Nos. 3-4), specifically question 3. The document number for the confidential filing is 07748-2024, and the document number for the request for confidential classification is 07629-2024.

PCS Phosphate's [White Springs'] response to POD No. 3 can be described as participation information related to goal-setting. In its request for confidentiality, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would harm DEF, as the information relates to security measures and competitive interests. DEF asserts disclosure of this information would impair the competitive business of the provider/owner of the information.

Staff has reviewed DEF's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(c), and 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 07748-2024 be approved.
