Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric") hereby provides notice that the company's Electric Vehicle Charging Pilot Program ("Pilot") terminated on April 21, 2025.

On April 21, 2021, the Commission entered Order No. PSC-2021-0144-PAA-EI (the "Order"). The Order approved Tampa Electric's Pilot for a period of four years beginning on April 21, 2021 and ending April 21, 2025 unless the company filed a petition to extend, modify, or permanently implement the Pilot through a tariff revision by that date. Tampa Electric did not file such a petition,¹ meaning the Pilot expired on April 21, 2025 per the terms of the Order.

The Order also specifies the accounting treatment for Pilot assets that apply when the Pilot terminates. Tampa Electric complied with the accounting treatment specified in the Order.
