Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statues (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida, LLC (DEF or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information filed in Docket No. 20250001-EI, dated May 1, 2025.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its filing under Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (d) "[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms."

More specifically, the information relates to claimed propriety separated fuel commodity cost and fuel transportation cost data, as well as quality-related cost adjustments. As such, the information in question concerns bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of DEF to contract for goods or services on favorable terms in the future. Furthermore, the Company requests that the confidential information be protected from disclosure for a period of 24 months.

Staff has reviewed the Company's information and confidentiality request. It is staff's opinion the request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S.
