Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statues (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Tampa Electric Company (TECO or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information and motion for temporary protective order originally filed in Docket No. 20250001-EI, dated May 2, 2025.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its filing under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (e) "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

More specifically, the information at issue relates to claimed proprietary and confidential technical information regarding a third-party's (to TECO) analysis of electric plant equipment. TECO asserts that disclosure of this proprietary information would harmful to the competitive interests of the provider of the information.
