2	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to Item No. 20.
3	Mr. Prewett oh, there you are. Perfect. I am
4	used to looking to my left. Sorry about that.
5	You are recognized, sir.
6	MR. PREWETT: Good afternoon, Commissioners.
7	I am Devan Prewett with the Division of Economics.
8	Item 20 is a joint petition by Central Florida
9	Electric Cooperative and Duke Energy Florida
10	requesting approval of the utility's proposed 2025
11	territorial agreement in Dixie, Gilchrest, Levy,
12	Marion and Alachua Counties.
13	The joint petitioners seek to make territorial
14	boundary changes to transfer 211 customers from
15	Central Florida to Duke and 45 customers from Duke
16	to Central Florida, thereby correcting inadvertent
17	connections and eliminating hazardous conditions in
18	each of the utility's territories.
19	Additionally, the proposed agreement would
20	amend the service you territories for each utility
21	to more clearly delineate their service
22	territories, help the joint petitioners gain
23	further operational efficiencies, and improve
24	customer service and address circumstances giving
25	rise to uneconomic duplication of service

1	facilities.
2	The joint petitioners have notified affected
3	customers, and they expect to coordinate the
4	transfer of all customers over a 36-month period
5	upon approval of the Commission.
6	Staff recommends approval of this joint
7	petition.
