My name is Lisa Greer. I am a resident of South Miami Dade. I live at: 14781 SW 238 Str, Homestead and am not employed by FPL. I live within 8.5 miles of Turkey Point Nuclear Plant.

I and my family lived through and beyond Hurricane Andrew, when power lines were not strengthened or hardened to protect the consumer from significant outages.

I was appreciative of FPL's service then and with all of the hardening that has been done in recent years and continues to be done today, I remain appreciative of FPL's service. If/when a hurricane hits, the expectation of outages is minimized considerably because of all of the work that has been done.

I am also supportive of FPL's solar farms located in South Miami Dade, as they are clean, quiet, and do not cause any further traffic congestion to the communities.

Further, the Turkey Point Clean Water Recovery addition, reusing up to 15 million gallons of reclaimed wastewater per day is an efficient, effective and innovative use for cooling the plant with otherwise unclean water.
