JOINT MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF STIPULATION

Florida Rising, Inc., Environmental Confederation of Southwest Florida, Inc. (“ECOSWF”), the League of United Latin American Citizens of Florida (“LULAC”), and Electrify America, LLC (“Electrify America”), pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, hereby jointly move the Commission to admit the testimony and exhibits of Electrify America’s Witness Jigar J. Shah into the record of this proceeding, to approve the following stipulations in lieu of cross-examination of Witness Shah, and to excuse Witness Shah from appearing at the hearing scheduled for this case. The stipulations to which Florida Rising, ECOSWF, LULAC, and Electrify America have agreed are as follows:

1. Witness Shah did not have an external independent study conducted to support Electrify America’s proposal to increase the number of hours used to calculate billed demand from 75 hours per month to 150 hours per month.
2. Witness Shah did not have an external independent study conducted demonstrating the effect of Electrify America’s proposal for the Commission to reduce FPL’s proposed rate increases to the GSD-1EV and GSLD-1EV tariffs on FPL’s general body of rate payers.
3. Witness Shah did not have an external independent study conducted demonstrating the rate base and other cost impacts of any/all of Electrify America’s proposals on FPL’s general body of rate payers.

Electrify America is agreeable to this stipulation being entered into the record, subject to the Commission's approval, and Florida Rising, ECOSWF and LULAC are agreeable to waiving cross-examination of Mr. Shah. The foregoing stipulations are provided in lieu of cross-examination that Florida Rising, ECOSWF, and LULAC would otherwise conduct of Witness Shah and do not change the positions of any of the Movants. Accordingly, the Movants request that the Commission excuse Mr. Shah from appearing at the hearing.

The Movants have conferred with all parties via electronic mail, regarding this motion, and no party objects. Specifically, the following parties do not object to the motion and do not object to Mr. Shah being excused from appearing at the hearing: Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, Floridians Against Increased Rates, Inc., EVgo Services, LLC, Florida Public Service Commission Staff, Office of Public Counsel, Americans for Affordable Clean Energy, Inc., Circle K Stores, Inc., RaceTrac, Inc. and Wawa, Inc., Walmart, Inc. and Florida Power & Light Company.

WHEREFORE, Florida Rising, ECOSWF, LULAC and Electrify America respectfully move the Commission to approve this stipulation and to enter it into the record of this docket, and to excuse Mr. Shah from appearing at the hearing.
