Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) requests confidential classification of information provided in supplemental response to OPC's 1st request of production of documents No. 27.

Based on staffs review, the information provided in the supplemental response to OPC's first production of documents No. 27 contains proprietary confidential business information concerning bids or other contractual data. The disclosure of which would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. Specifically, the information contains service charges billed to affiliates, which if disclosed to the public could be used to determine negotiated pricing paid by FPL. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 03989-2025 be approved pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S.
