Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) requests confidential classification of documents and information provided in responses to OPC's first set of interrogatories No. 28 and first request for production of documents Nos. 30 and 43.

Based on staffs review, the information provided in the responses to OPC's first set of interrogatories No. 28 and first request of production of documents No. 30, contains information related to FPL's competitive interest, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business interests of FPL. OPC's first set of production of documents No. 43 contains information related to FPL's competitive interests and information related to security measures, systems or procedures of FPL's transmission, substation, and distribution facilities. Specifically, the materials in response to OPC's first ROG No. 28, contain information related to employee compensation, which if released to the public could impact the ability to hire and retain employees. The material in response to OPC's first POD No. 30, contains non-public information related to the decisions, strategy, and planning of the NextEra Energy, Inc. Board of Directors and its committees. The materials in response to OPC's first POD No. 43, contains FPL's non-public transmission system panning and strategy, also critical energy infrastructure information. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 03864-2025 be approved pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(c)(e), F.S.
