Commissioners:

I am a resident of Grenelefe and write to express my opposition to the proposed astronomical and unprecedented water rate increase.

If implemented, the proposed rates would increase water and wastewater rates to unprecedented and patently unaffordable levels, with 5,000 gallons of residential water usage jumping from \$14.31 per month to \$107.41 and 2,000 gallons of wastewater per month increasing from \$15.84 to \$201.60. These proposed increases of between 700% and 1,300% are not only exorbitant and unaffordable, but are far, far in excess of typical rates in the region and the State.

The residents of this community cannot afford to pay such an astronomical increase, and should not be asked to do so.

It is my understanding that the owner of the water utility represented to the county that he and his entities would fund all costs associated with the project, and as evidenced by the affidavit attached below as Exhibit A, it

appears that Polk County relied on this representation as part of the approval process for the utility owner's project. As Mr. House represented to the County, he and his entities should, as promised, pay these costs. The attempt to pass these costs on to residents (who clearly will in no way benefit from Mr. House's development project) and breaking his sworn promise, is reprehensible and simply unfair.

Accordingly, I respectfully request that the Commission deny the proposed rate increases.
