Executive Summary

Introduction

This tariff filing extends to Centrex service provided from a Siemens® EWSD switch the availability of Primary Rate ISDN (PRI) interface to interexchange carrier switches. This tariff filing also converts the Centrex Control feature from dedicated facility access to Internet access.

Description of Tariff

This tariff provides the ability to connect Centrex switches to interexchange carrier switches using PRI facilities which is currently available only in Nortel and Lucent switches. This filing extends this functionality to Siemens EWSD switches.

The Centrex Control feature currently requires a subscriber to provide terminal equipment and dedicated access lines to utilize this feature. Internet access will facilitate the use of this feature for existing and potential customers.

2. Telephone numbers reserved for future use includes preassigned telephone numbers and the facilities required. Such telephone numbers and facilities will be removed from reserved status and assigned as active station lines as requested by the customer.
3. The assignment of telephone numbers and the sequence of numbers assigned to a subscriber's system is made at the discretion of the Company.
4. The service is furnished subject to the availability of facilities and telephone numbers.
5. Calls to reserved (unassigned) telephone numbers will be routed to intercept common recorded announcement facilities as specified in A12.25.1.A. of this Tariff.
6. Telephone numbers furnished herein retain their reserved status until assigned to a station line at which time the service assumes rates and charges applicable to a BellSouth® Centrex service station line.
