#### 5.1.2 Description of Features

- A. Blocking Service or a telephonic block can only be removed pursuant to a written request by the customer of record, or the customer of record providing the correct password over the telephone, or by a request made in person by such customer. The customer of record can provide a personal password to use to remove blocking service at the time blocking service is established.
- B. Direct Trunk Overflow (DTO)

The Direct Trunk Overflow feature gives the Customer another termination option if all of their DID trunks are busy. This all-trunks-busy condition may be caused either by legitimate heavy incoming traffic or by a trouble condition where the T-1 system is down and the 5ESS senses that trouble as an all-trunks-busy condition. During either busy condition, the incoming call attempts to terminate to the DID group. When the 5ESS sees all trunks busy, it will choose an alternate route for the call to a telephone number that is programmed in the 5ESS only. ### 7.2.5 Term Liability/Termination Charges

## **Blocking Service**

### General

Blocking Service is a feature that permits a Customer to restrict access from his or her telephone line to various discretionary services. Blocking Service is available where equipment and facilities permit. The Company will not be liable for any charge incurred when any long distance carrier or alternative operator service provider accepts third number billed or collect calls. The following blocking options are available to Residential and Business Customers:

- A. Option #1 allows the Customer to block the following calls: Operator 0-, Operator 0+, 1+900, 1+555-1212, 1+NPA-555-1212, 411, 976 and 1+976.
- B. Option #2 allows the Customer to block the following calls: 976, 1+976, Operator 0and Operator 0+.
- C. Option #3 allows the Customer to block the following calls: Operator 0-, Operator 0+, 1+900, 1+555-1212 and 1+NPA-555-1212.
- D. Option #4 allows the Customer to block the following calls: 976, 1+976 and 1+900.

### Rates

A. Options #1-#3. The nonrecurring charge for each line of Blocking service is \$10.00. The monthly rate of Blocking Service is as follows:
