ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

By petition filed November 17, 1997, St. Johns River Water Management District (District), by and through its attorneys, Nancy B. Barnard and Jennifer B. Springfield, requests leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In its petition, the District states that it has a substantial interest in the outcome of this proceeding, in that approval of implementation of Sanlando Utility Corporation's (Sanlando or utility) water conservation plan will forward the state and District objectives of conserving water in the geographical area of the utility. The District is authorized by Chapter 153, Florida Statutes, to regulate the consumptive use of water and to promote the conservation, development, and proper utilization of water. No responses were filed in opposition to the petition.

Because it appears that the District's substantial interests may be affected in this proceeding, the petition shall be granted. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, the District takes the case as it finds it. 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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: 1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.038(2), Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; 2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or 3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
