ORDER AMENDING CONSUMMATING ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. PSC-2026-0134-PAA-TX, issued May 7, 2026, this Commission proposed to take certain action, subject to a Petition for Formal Proceeding as provided in Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code or payment in full of the Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) including statutory late payment charges. Consummating Order No. PSC-2026-0191-CO-TX was issued on June 2, 2026, to acknowledge that Order No. PSC-2026-0134-PAA-TX had become final and effective. The order stated that if the entity failed to pay any outstanding RAF, in full, including any accrued statutory late payment charges, penalties and cost of collection, it would be referred to the Florida Department of Financial Services for further collection efforts. Payment, including late payment charges and penalties, was received on June 22, 2026, prior to referral to the Florida Department of Financial Services. It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-2026-0134-PAA-TX has become effective and final. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-2026-0191-CO-TX is hereby amended to reflect that payment was made by Open Infra East Inc. in Docket No. 20260058-TX prior to referral to the Florida Department of Financial Services and Open Infra East Inc. is in compliance and its local exchange certificate is active. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-2026-0191-CO-TX is reaffirmed in all other respects.

ORDERED that this docket shall be closed.

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any judicial review of Commission orders that is available pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Office of Commission Clerk and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
