FINAL ORDER ON JURISDICTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

At the Special Agenda Conference held on November 16, 1988, the three-member panel disposed of all issues in the above-captioned proceeding except the following issue:

Issue lA: Under what circumstances, if any, is a mobile carrier an IXC for purposes of Florida Public Service Commission jurisdiction under Florida law? What regulatory requirements should apply?

With regard to this issue (herein, the "Jurisdiction Issue"), the panel voted two-to-one to refer it to the full Commission for disposition. However, Rule 25-22.0355(3), Florida Administrative Code (the Rule), provides that a majority of the Commission must decide that the full Commission shall hear a case assigned to a panel.

The question of whether the Jurisdiction Issue should be referred was presented to the full Commission at its Agenda Conference held on December 20, 1988, in order for the Rule to be applied. The full Commission voted three-to-two against referral, and consequently the Jurisdiction Issue was not referred to the full Commission.

Accordingly, the three-member panel considered the Jurisdiction Issue at the December 20, 1988 Agenda Conference. The panel decided not to assert jurisdiction over mobile carriers at this time.

In view of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the hearing issue regarding whether mobile carriers fall under Commission jurisdiction as interexchange carriers shall not be referred to the full Commission for disposition. It is further

ORDERED that Florida Public Service Commission jurisdiction will not be asserted over mobile carriers at this time. It is further

ORDERED that this docket shall remain open.
