## ORDER GRANTING UTILITY EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY

By Motion for Extension of Time filed by Sunshine Utilities November 15, 1989, the Utility has requested an extension of time to file its prefiled direct testimony in this proceeding.
