WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Bradford County, Florida was regularly assembled on December 19, 1990, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Bradford County, Florida acknowledges that the lack of toll free dialing within Bradford County and between Bradford County, Union County and the Gainesville area causes serious communications problems for business interests, and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Commission has a method whereby approval can be obtained for Extended Area Service, and

WHEREAS, Such Extended Area Service would not only improve the economy of the County, but would also serve to lower consumer prices and improve the unification of community-wide and inter-community interests,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Bradford County, Florida that the Public Service Commission, Central Telephone, Alltel Corporation, Southern Bell and any other entities as need to be involved, be requested to take necessary steps in a sincere effort to secure Extended Area Service between Bradford County, Union County and the Gainesville area, and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Starke-Bradford County Chamber of Commerce supports such effort and urges telephone customers to vote in favor of area-wide toll free dialing.
