

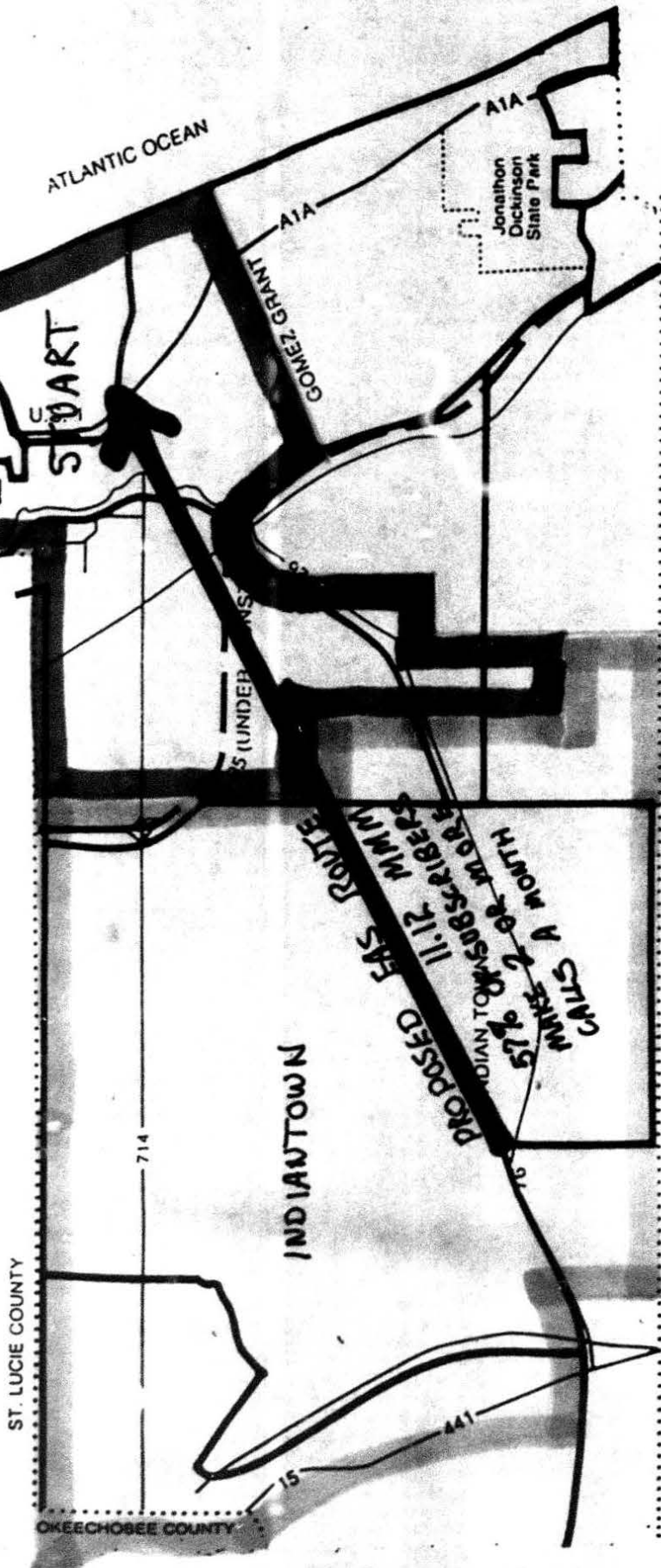

Indiantown and Stuart**

It would appear from the traffic studies that a community of interest exists between Indiantown and Stuart. The calling rate of 11.12 and the indication of 57% of the subscribers making at least two (2) calls per month would bear this out.

Stuart is the county seat of Martin County, it offers entertainment opportunities, provides medical facilities, professional services and retail establishments not available in Indiantown.

The Indiantown exchange is composed mainly of a sparsely populated rural area dealing mainly in agricultural pursuits. Stuart is a more densely populated urban area that serves as the economic hub of this area.

It appears that this interest is historic and not the result of recent changes.
