FLORIDA CITIES WATER COMPANY'S RESPONSE TO ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED AT RULEMAKING HEARING

Florida Cities Water Company, by and through its undersigned counsel, files this response to Order No. PSC-93-0683-PCO-WS:

- 1. Florida Cities Water Company will file concurrently herewith Supplemental Comments in response to the last filing it has received from the Florida Fire Sprinkler Association. These are in addition to the Comments filed by Florida Cities Water Company on April 23, 1993 pursuant to the Commission's Notice of Rulemaking.
- 2. Florida Cities Water Company requests that Larry Coel and Mike Acosta be given an opportunity to address the Commission in support of its comments. We respectfully suggest the 20 minutes allotted by Order No. PSC-93-0683-PCO-WS would be insufficient for Florida Cities Water Company to explain its positions.
- 3. Florida Cities Water Company intends to address the following matters at hearing. We oppose proposed Rule 25-30.435 and 25-30.020(2) and intend to provide testimony thereon at the hearing. We also oppose 25-30.433(3), but will only need to briefly elaborate further on the position of the Florida Waterworks Association, which we support. Finally, we intend to provide testimony in opposition to positions advocated by the Florida Fire Sprinkler Association in connection with proposed rule 25-30.465, which we support.
