<u>Issue 2:</u> Recommendation that, upon request by the customer, the utility should change out, at its own expense, the 1" meters for a  $5/8" \ge 3/4"$ meter, provided the customer's consumption level justifies the installation of a  $5/8" \ge 3/4"$  meter. The utility should not be required to refund the difference in the large meter and small meter fee. The utility should notify the affected customers that they may request a meter change at the utility's expense. This notice should be included with the notice recommended in Issue No. 1 and should be reviewed by the staff prior to mailing to utility customers.

Issue 3: Recommendation that this docket be closed at the conclusion of the proposed agency action period in Issue No. 2, if no timely protect is filed.
