MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF DURATION  
OF ORDER GRANTING CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION  
(Docket No. 910163-TL)**

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Motion for Extension of Duration of Order Granting Confidential Classification, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

1. On June 24, 1991, Southern Bell filed a Motion for Confidential Treatment and Permanent Protective Order for

documents that were produced to the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") in response to Item No. 1 of the First Request for Production of Documents by OPC. One of the documents produced in response thereto has been identified as Document No. 6337-91.

2. By an Order issued August 17, 1992, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") granted in part Southern Bell's Motion for Confidential Classification of information contained in this document. (Order No. PSC-92-1003-CFO-TL) Specifically, the Commission approved Southern Bell's request for confidential classification of customer specific information contained in this document.

3. Under the provisions of Rule 25-22.006(8)(a), an order granting confidential classification is effective for 18 months. Therefore, the confidential classification granted in this Order expires on March 17, 1994. The Commission may, however, extend the period of confidentiality for good cause shown.

4. The document in question remains in the possession of the Office of Public Counsel. Although, there is no longer a need (for purposes of this docket) for OPC to keep this document, OPC has received a subpoena to produce these and other documents in the case styled Peoples Telephone Co. vs. BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., United States District Court, Southern District of Florida; Case No. 93-1260-CIV-KING. Southern Bell has moved to quash this subpoena on January 31, 1994. OPC has taken the position that it cannot return these documents under the Commission's rules that would normally pertain while the

dispute surrounding the subpoena in the above-styled case remains unresolved.


5. The reasons that Southern Bell asserted in support of confidential treatment in its original motion continue to pertain. Specifically, there is still a need to protect the privacy of Southern Bell customers who are identified in these documents.


6. For the reasons set forth above, Southern Bell hereby requests that this Commission enter an Order extending the period of confidential classification for an additional 18 months, or for any longer period of time that the documents remain within the possession of the Office of Public Counsel.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Southern Bell respectfully requests the entry of an Order extending the period of confidential classification as described above.
