## FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") moves the Commission for a two week extension of time through and including February 6, 1995 within which to file the company's Demand Side management Plan, and as grounds therefor, says:

- 1. Under the current schedule, Demand Side Management Plans of Florida Power & Light Company, Tampa Electric Company and Gulf Power Company are due to be filed January 23, 1995. Florida Power Corporation has sought and been granted a one month filing extension until February 22, 1995.
- 2. The amount of time required to assemble FPL's Plan has turned out to be greater than anticipated. FPL needs a brief extension of time to submit its DSM plan.
- 3. A two week extension of time from the current due date of January 23, 1995 through and including February 6, 1995 would enable FPL to submit its DSM Plan in a more carefully prepared manner. The requested extension of time is very brief and should

not prevent any difficulty for the Commission, its Staff or any of the parties participating in this docket. If FPL is able to complete its plan prior to February 6, 1995, it will go ahead and file it rather than using the full two week extension the company is requesting.

4. FPL has contacted both LEAF and Peoples Gas System, Inc., the only other parties to this docket, regarding FPL's requested extension. Peoples Gas has no objection. LEAF has no objection as long as the remainder of the procedural schedule is extended two weeks as well.

WHEREFORE, Florida Power & Light Company moves the Commission for an extension of time through and including February 6, 1995 within which to submit the company's DSM Plan.
