SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF DURATION OF ORDER GRANTING CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION Order No. PSC-93-1349-CFO-TL

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company") and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Motion for Extension of Duration of Order Granting Confidential Classification, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

1. On May 20, 1993, Southern Bell filed a Request for Confidential Classification for portions of the deposition transcripts of Southern Bell employees Clyde Bourne, Hampton Booker, Patricia Moran, Diane Edwards, Charlie Chasteen, Nadine Thomas and Douglas Marquis. The Commission assigned Document Nos. 5515-93, 5517-93, 5519-93, 5521-93, 5523-93, 5525-93 and 5527-93

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respectively to this material.

- 2. By an Order issued September 15, 1993, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") granted in part and denied in part Southern Bell's Request for Confidential Classification of portions of the employee depositions. (Order No. PSC-93-1349-CFO-TL) Specifically, the Commission approved Southern Bell's request for confidential classification for home addresses, home telephone numbers, and for those portions where the deponent identifies individuals who allegedly engaged in improper activities found in the deposition transcripts.
- 3. Under the provision of Rule 25-22.006 (8) (a), an order granting confidential classification is effective for 18 months. Therefore, the confidential classification granted in this Order expires on March 15, 1995. The Commission may, however, extend the period of confidentiality for good cause shown.
- 4. The information in question remains in the possession of the Staff.
- 5. The reasons Southern Bell asserted in support of confidential treatment in its original motion continue to pertain. Specifically, there is still a need to protect employee personal information and the identity of employees allegedly engaged in improper activities from disclosure.
- 6. For the reasons set forth above and in the two original Request for Confidential Classification filed on May 20, 1993, Southern Bell hereby requests that this Commission enter an Order extending the period of confidential classification for an

additional 18 months, or for any longer period of time that the documents remain within the possession of staff.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Southern Bell respectfully requests the entry of an Order extending the period of confidential classification as described above.
