ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATES NOS. 337-W AND 292-S TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY, AMENDING CERTIFICATE NO. 341-W TO DELETE TERRITORY, AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

Hydratech Utilities, Inc. (Hydratech or utility), a Class A utility, provides water and wastewater service to approximately 5,805 water customers and 4,114 wastewater customers in Martin County. The utility's 1994 annual report shows an annual operating revenue of \$1,998,407 and a net operating loss of \$2,038.

On March 28, 1995, Hydratech applied for an amendment of its Water Certificate No. 337-W and of its Wastewater Certificate No. 292-S to include additional territory; and to delete certain of those areas from Hobe Sound Water Company's (Hobe Sound) Water Certificate No. 341-W. On May 17, 1995 Hydratech amended its application to request the addition of an approximately seventy-one acre parcel of land to its water and wastewater service area.

The application is in compliance with the governing statute, Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, and other pertinent statutes and administrative rules concerning an application for amendment of certificate. The application contained a check in the amount of \$3,500, which represents the correct filing fees pursuant to Rule 25-30.020, Florida Administrative Code. The applicant has provided evidence, in the form of warranty deed, that the utility owns the land upon which its facilities are located, as required by Rule 25-30.036(1)(d), Florida Administrative Code.

Adequate service territory and system maps and a territory description have been provided, as prescribed by Rule 25-30.036(1)(e), (f) and (i), Florida Administrative Code. Descriptions of the territory requested by the utility are appended to this Order as Attachments A - E, and are incorporated herein by reference.

DOCUMENT SEMPLES - DATE

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FPSC-RECORDS/REPORTING

The utility has submitted an affidavit, consistent with Section 367.045(2)(d), Florida Statutes, that it has tariffs and annual reports on file with the Commission. In addition, the application contains proof of compliance with the noticing provisions set forth in Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code. No objections to the application were received. We note that this development is in Martin County, and that Martin County's comprehensive plan has been approved. Martin County has advised us by letter that it does not object to the amendment of Hydratech's certificates.

Hydratech has provided water and wastewater service to the Hobe Sound/Stuart area for many years. One of the managers of the utility has been involved in utility operations, management, and construction for over twenty-five years, and is a Registered Professional Engineer in the State of Florida. The utility's field supervisor and lead operator holds both a Class A Water and a Class A Wastewater Operator's License. Although the utility had a slight operating loss, as indicated by the 1994 annual report, the addition of these customers will only add to the stability of the utility by increasing its customer base.

The utility recently expanded its wastewater treatment plant, and the water treatment plant is in the process of expansion. The utility transmits its treated effluent for use as spray irrigation to two golf courses. Therefore, it is apparent that the utility has wastewater treatment capacity and will have the water treatment capacity to serve these customers. The internal water and wastewater lines will be donated to the utility. The Department of Environmental Protection has no outstanding notices of violation issued for these systems. In addition, the utility was awarded the best operated wastewater treatment plant and water distribution system in its region in 1994. Consequently, we believe the utility has demonstrated the financial and technical expertise to provide quality service to these customers.

Based on the foregoing, we find that it is in the public interest to grant Hydratech's application for amendment of Water Certificate No. 337-W and Wastewater Certificate No. 292-S to include the territory described in Attachments A, B, C and D. Hobe Sound's Certificate No. 341-W shall be amended to delete the territory described in Attachment E.

Hydratech has filed revised tariff sheets, incorporating the additional territory into its tariff. The utility has also filed revised tariff sheets on behalf of Hobe Sound, deleting the portions of territory from Hobe Sound's tariff which correspond to those portions of the additional territory requested by Hydratech

that currently fall within Hobe Sound's service area. Moreover, Hydratech has returned its certificates, as well as Hobe Sound's water certificate, for entry reflecting the additional territory of Hydratech and the deletion of territory of Hobe Sound.

By Order No. 22226, issued December 28, 1989, in Docket No. 880882-WU, the Commission granted the utility a water rate and a service availability increase. Wastewater rates and service availability charges were approved by Order No. 9730, issued January 19, 1981, in Docket No. 790164-WS. The utility's water and wastewater rates were last changed on March 12, 1995, with a pass-through and index rate increase. The rates and charges currently approved in the utility's tariffs shall be effective for the customers in the additional service territory. Because no further action is necessary, this docket shall be closed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Certificates Nos. 337-W and 292-S, held by Hydratech Utilities, Inc., are hereby amended to include the territory described in Attachments A, B, C, and D of this Order, which are incorporated herein by reference. It is further

ORDERED that Certificate No. 341-W, held by Hobe Sound Water Company, is hereby amended to delete the territory described in Attachment E of this Order, which is incorporated herein by reference. It is further

Ordered that Hydratech Utilities, Inc., shall charge the customers in the territory added herein the rates and charges approved in its tariffs authorized to change by this Commission. It is further

ORDERED that this docket is hereby closed.

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900 (a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
