AGENDA CONFERENCE OF OPC'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

OF ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE

At the agenda conference on November 7th, the Commission considered three of OPC's Motions to Dismiss, and discussed at length whether the synopsis and initial customer notice were sufficient. Several commissioners indicated that even if those documents might be technically correct (at least one commissioner indicated that he thought the documents might not even be technically correct), that the Commission might still need to do more to fully inform and protect the customers.

In addition to filing the above-noted Motions to Dismiss, the OPC has also filed a Motion for Reconsideration of the Order Establishing Procedure, and in that motion has again attacked the sufficiency of the synopsis and initial customer notice. Staff had written its Recommendation concerning the Motion for Reconsideration, but is now exploring what other options are open to the Commission. However, at this time, staff has not fully delineated the issues and recommendations are due to Carol Purvis at noon today. She has advised staff that she could wait as late as 5:00 p.m. today to be given the issues, but that if we needed more time we would need to get your approval.
