of record dated January 12, 1990, files this preliminary statement
of issues and positions, saying:

Generic Energy Conservation Cost Recovery Issues

ISSUE 1: What is the appropriate adjusted net true-up amount for
the period October, 1994 through September, 1995?

GULF: Under recovery \$166,846. (Neyman)

ISSUE 2: What is the appropriate projected end-of-period total net
true-up amount for the period October, 1995 through
March, 1996?

GULF: Over recovery \$189,287. (Neyman)

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
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
