On May 31, 1996, Florida Public Service Commission Order No. PSC-96-0657-FOF-WS became final in Docket No. Which which investigates possible overearnings of the company. The order requires Indiantown Company, Post Office Box 397, Indiantown, FL 34956, to decrease its water rates to the rates that were in effect prior to a 1994 price index adjustment and to refund revenues attributable to the price index adjustment with interest.

The decrease will be effective for water service received on and after July 19, 1996, the most recent date meters were read. Bills received on or about September 1, 1996, will reflect service at the decreased rate.

The refund will be made as a reduction on the bill you receive on or about September 1, 1996.
