Cheryl Walla, files this notice of response for the Commission to disallow FCWC FDEP letter into an already closed record and reject this as a new exhibit into this case, and states:

- At the time of hearing in this proceeding, the permitted capacity of 1.5 MGD to 1.25MGD on the construction permit was a controversy in this This construction permit was changed AFTER this increase was protested and brought to light by the people.
- 2. The July 19,1996 FDEP letter simply acknowledged completion of construction and that FCWC permitted capacity is 1.25MGD. The question still and always has been the hydraulic and biologic treatment capacity of this plant and not how much water FDEP will allow FCWC to flow into the river or to the golf course.
- If the Commission reopens the record and receives new exhibits from FCWC in this 12th hour with agenda conference on August 13, 1996 each party to the case should be accommodated the same provisions of reopening the record and entering new exhibits, as would only be appropriate.

WHEREFORE, Cheryl Walla moves that:

- 1. The Commission disallow notice of FDEP letter from FCWC.
- 2. The Commission reject reopening the closed record and not receive this new exhibit.
 - 3. No further relief is DUE by the Commission to this utility.
