Issue 1: Recommendation that prima facie evidence of meter tampering outlined in Florida Power & Light Company's reports makes it reasonable to believe that meter tampering occurred at Mr. Jorge Morales' residence at 6550 Southwest 17th Street, Miami. As the customer of record during the entire period, Mr. Morales should be held responsible for a reasonable amount of backbilling.

Issue 2: Recommendation that FPL's calculation of a backbilled amount of \$1,795.63 for unmetered electric usage, plus a \$264.96 investigative charge, totaling \$2,060.59, is reasonable.
