<u>Issue 2:</u> Recommendation that OPC's motion for reconsideration and clarification or, in the alternative motion to modify stay be denied. The Commission lacks jurisdiction at this time to make a ruling on OPC's motion. However, the Commission should immediately request that the First District Court of Appeals relinquish jurisdiction of the Commission's order for the purpose of addressing the issues raised by OPC and the concerns identified by staff.
