Thank you for your letter concerning the proposed rate increase requested by Florida Power Corporation (FPC) in Docket No 970001-EI, Fuel and Purchased Power Cost Recovery Clause and Generating Performance Incentive Factor. I am prohibited by Florida law from commenting on the merits of pending dockets before the Commission, however, I will share with you some of the procedural aspects of this docket.

FPC's requested increase will be heard by the Commission at our regularly scheduled fuel cost recovery hearing starting February 19, 1997. As you pointed out in your letter, the requested rate increase is primarily due to the Crystal River nuclear unit outage. Specifically, electricity that was generated from nuclear fuel is now being replaced by electricity generated from higher cost fossil fuels. The requested increase is to pay for this higher cost fuel.

In closing, let me assure you that I, along with my fellow Commissioners assigned to this case will thoroughly evaluate all issues brought before us.

Thank you for your letter of February 7, 1997, regarding Florida Power Corporation's proposed fuel charge increase.

The rate increase proposed by Florida Power Corporation is being considered in the Commission's fuel adjustment proceeding (Docket No. 970001-EI), which is an ongoing proceeding designed to review the fuel costs passed through to customers in the fuel charge. While I am not currenty assigned to this proceeding, I can assure you that the Commission very carefully scrutinizes the costs passed through to customers. The Commission conducts audits of the companies' fuel adjusment filings to make sure that only those costs reasonably necessary to acquire fuel are recovered.

The panel assigned to this case will hear testimony and evidence pertaining to this matter during a public hearing scheduled for February 19-21, 1997. It is at this hearing that the Commission would consider evidence relating to any allegations of mismanagement. It is customary for fuel adjustment panels to render "bench decisions," meaning that a decision will likely be made at the hearing directly after the presentation of evidence. The Commission's order is scheduled to be issued on March 12, 1997.

Because this is a pending matter, it would not be appropriate for me to comment on the merits of the

Dear Chairwoman Johnson and Commissioner:

I am writing to you about the proposed rate increase by Florida Power.

Recently these rate increases seen to parallel the diversification Florida Power has taken into other businesses. Since they are literally granted a monopoly in the electric power area, this could lead some to believe that these rate increases may be underwriting more than power related activity.

This coupled with the alleged poor management at the Crystal River Nuclear Plant seems to indicate rate increases are used to make up for poor management decisions about their core business.

I would strongly encourage that there be no rate increase granted until these areas of concern are satisfactorily addressed. Even then, I would be most reluctant about the granting of a rate increase due to the fact that Florida Power's customers are already paying the highest rates in the state.
