Issue 1: Recommendation that the Commission deny World Long Distance, Inc.'s motion for immediate grant of certificate of public convenience and necessity and defer its decision on World Long Distance, Inc.'s application for a certificate, pending the outcome of Docket No. 960217-TI. Further, the Commission should order World Long Distance, Inc. to discontinue intrastate interexchange carrier service in Florida until it is granted a certificate.

Issue 3: Recommendation that, if the Commission approves Issue No. 1, this docket should remain open until the Commission resolves the show cause proceeding against Telecuba in Docket No. 960217-TI. Upon resolution of Docket No. 960217-TI, the Commission shall decide whether WLD should be granted a certificate.

If the Commission denies Issue No. 1 and grants or denies Issue No. 2, this docket should be closed unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by this decision files a protest with the Commission within 21 days of issuance of the proposed agency action order.
