PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF ENVIRONMENTAL COST RECOVERY TRUE-UP FOR PERIOD ENDING SEPTEMBER 1996

Florida Power & Light Company (*FPL*) hereby Petitions this Commission for approval of FPL's final Environmental Cost Recovery true-up amount of \$61,308 overrecovery for the April 1996 - September 1996 period and an overrecovery of \$69,606 as the adjusted net true-up amount to be carried forward to the October 1997 through September 1998 period. In support of this Petition, FPL states as follows:

- 1. The final \$61,308 Environmental Cost Recovery overrecovery for the period April 1996 September 1996, was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Schedule A-2 for the Fuel Cost Recovery Clause, attached to Order 10093 dated June 19, 1981. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony of FPL witness R. Morley, which is being filed together with the Petition and incorporated herein.
- 2. The adjusted net true-up for the period of an overrecovery of \$69,606 is the difference between the actual true-up of \$61,308 overrecovery and the estimated/actual true-up of \$8,298 underrecovery approved by the Commission at the August 1996 hearing.

WHEREFORE, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests the Commission to approve the net \$61,308 environmental cost recovery overrecovery as the final true-up amount for the period ending September 1996, and an overrecovery of \$69,606 as the adjusted net true-up amount to be carried forward to the period beginning October 1997.
