RE: DOCKET NO. 970075-TI - Petition for partial waiver of Rule 25-4.113(4), F.A.C., by AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc., in order to allow it to offer combined billing service to customers upon request.

Issue 1: Should the Commission grant AT&T's petition for a waiver from the provisions of Rule 25-4.113(4)(e), F.A.C., which prohibits telephone companies from discontinuing service to a customer failing to pay for a company's service which is not regulated by the Commission?

Recommendation: Yes. AT&T's request for a waiver of Rule 25-4.113(4)(e), F.A.C. should be granted, thus allowing AT&T to disconnect long distance service to customers who fail to pay the combined balance on a bill containing charges for both long distance and wireless services. Further, AT&T should be ordered to notify customers prior to their election of combined billing that it is purely an option to separate billing.
