**JOINT MOTION FOR PERMANENT

Now comes BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), and the parties to this docket, namely American Communication Services of Jacksonville, Inc. ("ACSI"), AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. ("AT&T"), Florida Competitive Carriers Association ("FCCA"), Florida Cable Telecommunications Association ("FCTA"), Intermedia Communications Corporation ("Intermedia"), MCI Telecommunications Corporation ("MCI"), Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc. and WorldCom, Inc. ("WorldCom"), Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership and Sprint Metropolitan Network, Inc. ("Sprint"), Teleport Communications Group, Inc. ("TCG"), and Time Warner AxS of Florida, L.P. and Digital Media Partners ("Time Warner"), and file this Joint Motion for Permanent Protective Order. 
2. The parties, therefore, seek a permanent Protective Order that will include the following restrictions regarding information covered by a Notice of Intent to Seek Confidential Classification filed in this docket ("Proprietary Information").

- a. The dissemination of any Proprietary Information concerning ALEC parties will be limited to counsel of record;
- b. Non-party ALEC Proprietary Information will be disseminated only in the aggregate;
- c. The use of any Proprietary Information protected under this Order will be limited to this docket;
- d. The provisions of this Order will continue to govern all Proprietary Information unless and until a final order is rendered by the Commission or a court of competent jurisdiction determining that specific items of information are non-confidential at which time the Order will cease to apply to such non-confidential information, but will remain in effect as to the remainder of the information;

- e. This Order will not apply to information already in the public domain;
- f. This Order will supplement the procedure for use of confidential information set forth in the Prehearing Order and the Order Establishing Procedure issued in this docket.




