

Docket No. 971065-SU, Application For Increased Water Rates by Mid-County Services, Re: Inc. in Pinellas County.

Dear Mr. Melson:

We have reviewed the company's application including the minimum filing requirements submitted on September 4, 1997, on behalf of the above-mentioned utility. After reviewing this information, we find the minimum filing requirements to be deficient. The specifics are identified below:

- Rule 25-30.020(2)(e)(3) requires a fee of \$3,500 for a utility with the existing capacity 1. to serve from 2,001 to 4,000 ERCs. According to the MFRs, Mid-County Services, Inc. (MCS), currently has the capacity to serve 3,273 ERCs. MCS only remitted \$2,250.
- 2. Commission Form PSC/WAW 19 (11/93) on Schedule A-16 requires the utility to provide annual balances for Advances for Construction since the last rate case. This schedule is not complete. Schedule A-19 shows Advances for Construction on the utility's balance sheet, although none are reflected on Schedule A-2. The Advances for Construction should be shown on Schedule A-19 with an explanation as to why they are not shown on Schedule A-2.

Commission Form PSC/WAW 19 (11/93) on Schedule E-5 requires the utility to provide a schedule of miscellaneous service charges. This schedule is not complete. Schedule B-4 shows miscellaneous service revenue which should be listed on Schedule E-5. Commission Form PSC/WAW 19 (11/93) on Schedule E-5 requires the utility to provide
