Issue 1: Should the Commission impose a $\$ 500$ fine or cancel Mr. Miller's Pay Telephone Certificate No. 4357 for apparent violation of Rule $25-$ 4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees?

Recsmmendation: Yes. The Commission should impose a $\$ 500$ fine or cancel Mr. Miller's certificate if the fine and the regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalties and interest, are not received by the Commission within 5 business days after the conclusion of the 21-day protest period. The fine should be paid to the Florida Public Service Commission and forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section $364.285(1)$, Florida Statutes. If the Commission's Order is not protested and the fine and the regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalties and interest, are not received, certificate number 4357 should be canceled.
